ACM20121 Certificate II in Animal Care is designed for Secondary School students who are passionate about working with animals, their care and welfare.

VETiS funding is available for eligible students.

Students can earn up to 4 QCE Credits, gain a nationally recognised qualification, and embark on a pathway to work or further study in Animal Care or Grooming.

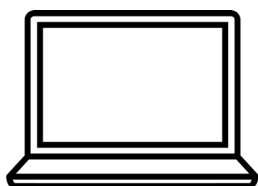
## Important Information for Schools

- Available to Senior Students enrolled in Secondary School in Years 10-12
- Students need access to a computer, a reliable internet connection and capacity for Zoom/Teams meetings
- Students will be required to complete observation tasks at an offsite location as part of their study. Students will be allocated a specific placement and will be required to attend their placement outside of school hours according to the needs of the business
- Schools need to provide supervisory teacher support only - no TAE required



### Assessment Methods

- Online study supported by an industry experienced trainer
- Demonstration of practical skills during offsite work placement



### Payment Options

- VETiS funding available for eligible students
- Fee for service options for students not eligible for VETiS funded training



### QCE Credits

- Students can earn up to 4 QCE credits on successful completion of the Certificate II qualification
- QCE credits are ascribed by QCAA in consideration of individual students learning accounts
