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HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

- Fast track the second qualification if enrolling in both the BSB and ICT qualifications

- Supplementary Assessments are completed with schoolteacher supervision and school teachers complete and submit observation reports to Skills Generation who will assess the students' work. Supervising School teachers DO NOT require a TAE!

COURSE FEES

HyFlex Skills includes Fee for Service options and VETiS funded options for students and schools.

VETiS Qualification:

CHC22015 Certificate II in Community Services

Funded by the Queensland Department of Education, Small Business and Training (DESBT) VET investment budget.

Students may be eligible for VETiS funding if they meet the following criteria:

- Students are either Australian or New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents
- Students are in either year 10, 11 or 12 when they participate in the course
- Students have not previously utilised VETiS funding

Students can speak to their school's VET Coordinator to check their eligibility for VETiS funding.
